SAFETY FIRST

PAINT YOUR PROP TIPS

At one time, nearly all props came from the manufacturer with brightly striped tips. These days props don't come with pre-painted markings.

The obvious reason for vivid paint on prop tips is to increase prop disc visibility. If it catches your eye, it might not catch your finger. Secondly, it makes your model look more scale like. Real aircraft have painted tips. Third, it's one way to balance your props. An extra coat of paint on the light blade can put it into balance. Following this tip may not prevent all mishaps but it is part of the many safety concepts we try to follow at the club.
